




#### Get involved in a Bible-Teaching Church

Habit Changes Made Easier by Jim Troyer

Every journey of a thousand miles starts with a single step. Often times, we have tried to make changes in ourselves, but have failed. Setting lofty goals is a gremlin to throwing your progress off track. Long term goals require more willpower than most can muster over a month or more. A nearly foolproof strategy is to set very shortterm goals that you know you can achieve.

If you desire to kick cigarette smoking or other strong habit, begin with very small steps. When feeling the urge to light up, work towards your goal by delaying your gratification. For example, delay lighting up for the longest time you believe you can handle. For some, this may be 10 seconds, for others one minute. Over the course of the next couple months, slowly stretch delays to longer times. However, if you find yourself regressing, then your goals have become too lofty. The solution is to reduce the delay so you can reach your goal.



#### The Value of Mentoring

There is such a huge need for mentors in the community for our young men. Many homes do not have fathers around consistently which leaves our young men trying to figure out what manhood looks like on their own. Our young men often times will develop hardened hearts and lose hope for a productive life while engaging in destructive behaviors such as violence, drugs, and gangs. There is no quick fix to addressing this issue, but God has the answer and its found in the local church community. We truly need Christian men to step up and become mentors to these young men. The local church has to engage with the families of these young men to reach them with the message of salvation through Christ. I have learned through the experience of mentoring that the traditional youth group is not enough for young men from single parent households. They really need one on one time with mature Christian men who will care about them, meet with them consistently, and give them godly counsel. Even though our young men can seem so hardened by life's circumstances, those hardened hearts can dissipate when God's love is shown through mentoring over time. I saw this first hand as I mentored four teenagers over a period of time. I did simple things with them such as play basketball, video games, and going out to eat with them at times. I put in a lot of time just hanging out with them and talking about life. They began to look to me as a big brother. One by one God used mentoring to introduce them to message of salvation, church and the bible. Every church can have a profound impact on our young men through mentoring.





Therefore, they come across as being too difficult or not understanding, yet their heart's desire is to see us free from the negative behavior patterns. If you are being impacted by someone who is continually engaging in destructive patterns in their life, I suggest you consider the following approaches in trusting God for their breakthrough:


Consider where they are in their relationship with Christ and pray accordingly: The only remedy for "sin" is grace. Therefore, the saving grace of God is the entrance into the arena of power that overcomes any condition in life. (Eph. 2:1-10)

Connect with others who have skills and proven success in dealing with such matters: The Bible speaks of the benefit of Godly counsel and the benefit it brings to life. (*Psalm* 1:1-3)

Commitment to a role of healthy involvement and not of an enabler: Sometime we can mean well, but we may be hindering what God is bringing to past through his loving discipline (*Prov. 3:11-12*).

If you have to endure having to live with the impact of negative patterns of others, know that God is there to keep you in a state of peace while you are interceding in prayer in the behalf of that person(s). Galatians 6:9 (NIV) says, "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.


