Introduction to Salvation

The Truth, the Whole Truth and Nothing but the Truth!

You cannot just have a part of God's word or truth; we must have the entire truth. Truth-be-told, only believing in God isn't enough! Knowing God is more than knowing about him. You have to develop a relationship with him. In order to do that you have to have a willing heart and mind to want to be in fellowship with him. Just like you develop relationships with the people around you; you have to develop one with him, the unseen God.

God's words tell us that, "as you believe in your heart AND confess with your mouth that Jesus Christ is Lord, then you will be saved". (Romans 10:9) To be "SAVED" spiritually means that a conversion or a God produced change took place in you due to Jesus Christ being received into your "HEART" When you receive Jesus Christ into your heart, His character and the power of God will bring change into your life. Sometimes it is experienced and seen quickly (right away) and other times it is not

as evident (apparent), but if you would just take the first step to receive him, the change will manifest. Now, the first step to salvation is to admit that you are a sinner. Romans 3:23 tells us that all have sinned and fell short of the glory of God. All sin, no matter how big or small, makes us sinners, which cuts us off from our Holy God: "For the wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ our Lord". (Romans 6:23) However, God presented himself as a sacrifice of atonement through faith in his blood. (Roman 3:25) This now means that because of the Savior you have the opportunity to be in right standing with him. So then you must repent. This act is showing regrets for sinning and asking for forgiveness (we must all do this). When you repent, it is a step to growth and maturity in Christ and in this life for yourself. Repentance should shut doors that allow evil spirits and wrong people into our lives and open doors for God to move and right


relationships to flow into those areas of our lives. This can only be done through the Holy Spirit as we submit or yield, to allow this change to take place in us. At this point by an act of faith on your part (believing that God is and trusting Him), you ask Jesus Christ into your heart as Savior and Lord. Pray this prayer: I am a sinner and I thank you for your forgiveness. I believe you died for my sins and rose from the dead. I trust and follow you as my Lord and Savior, guide my life and help me to do your will. Strengthen me with your power through your spirit, in Jesus, Amen Receive God's forgiveness. For, "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." (Romans 10:13) Now Believe! Trust that God has heard you, forgiven you and has your name written in the lamb's book of life. You must believe in your heart that Jesus bore your sins, died for you and rose again... (Romans 10:9). For God so loved the world that he gave his one and

only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16) God demonstrates his own love for you in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8) After receiving Jesus Christ into your heart, a "desire" to remain in that relationship with Him will come alive or exist in you. Therefore, you will "know" He lives in you! Don't take it for granted or be deceived, God has forgiven you for your sins. Yes it is true; it is also a process, for faith without works is dead. Believe in our Lord Jesus Christ and receive him as your savior today. Now admit this to at least one person. Remember we confess with our mouth and believe in our hearts. "Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God." (John 1:12)

Defining Salvation

Salvation - deliverance from the power and penalty of sins; **redemption**
 Save means to be delivered
 Surrender - to yield, to give oneself up
 Conversion - when a change takes place in your heart through the spirit of God
 Faith - believe that which is not seen; now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see
 Repentance - turning away from your sinful nature

and acknowledging your sin in the presence of God through prayer
 Holy Spirit - the third person of the Trinity (Father, Son, Holy Spirit) through whom God acts, reveals His will, empowers individuals and discloses His personal presence
 Believe - to have confidence in the truth, the existence, or the reliability of something
 Sin - transgression of divine law

Share Each Other's Burdens

Sharing life's struggles is fundamental to the way followers of Christ are called to live. As Paul challenged us, "Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ" (Gal 6:2) by working together through life's challenges we can help to strengthen and support one another when times are hard. You don't have to look like me or smell like me for me to do what is right. By expressing the care and affections of Christ toward one another, (your testimony of what God did for you and is doing) the difficulties of life should draw us to Christ and to each other-not isolate us in our suffering. By sharing in the struggles of another, we are modeling the love of Christ, and doing what we are called to do. We read in Isaiah, "Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows" (Isa 53:4). No matter how great the struggle we face, we never face it alone. (He died and rose again for us) Thank you, Father that I don't have to walk my life's journey alone. You are near.

We must capitalize on the opportunity to share Jesus Christ. We must witness to those and let them know and understand that it is in Jesus' name and their faith that their healing come. As Peters speaks in Acts 3 "Now, brothers, I know you acted out of ignorance, as did your leaders. But, this is how God fulfilled what he had foretold through all the prophets, saying that Christ would suffer. Repent and turn to God so that your sins may be wiped out. Times of refreshing may come from the Lord. And, He may send the Christ, who has been appointed for you. Did you know God has appointed Christ to bless our lives, if we let Him?

We must repent! When we repent! God promises not to only wipe away our

sins, but to also bring us refreshment. God always keeps His promises. Repentance may, at first, seem painful because it is hard to give up certain sins. But God will give you a better way in all things. As was promised in (Hosea 6:3), "Let us acknowledge the Lord; let us press on to acknowledge him. As surely as the sun rises, he will appear; he will come to us like the winter rains, like the spring rains that water the earth.

Do you feel a need to be refreshed? Find a place to worship, study your Bible, pray, seek help for more understanding, go to Bible study and seek to learn more with all your heart; then Jesus will reveal Himself to you because you would have started to build a relationship with Him. We can go a lot further together than we can alone!!!

He is 'the stone which you builders rejected, which has become the capstone.'

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.





Jesus Promise Rest for the Soul

(Matthew 11:28) Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. (v29) **TAKE MY YOKE UPON YOU AND LEARN FROM ME**, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

(John 13:15-17) I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. (V16) I tell you the truth, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. (v17) Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them.

(Philippians 2:5) Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus

****Jesus Christ was humble, willing to give up his rights in order to obey God and serve people. Like Christ, we should have a servant's attitude, serving out of love for God and for others, not out of guilt or fear. Remember, you can choose your attitude. You can look for opportunities to serve other. (Mark 10:45 for more on Christ's attitude)**

(Matthew 13:15) For this people's heart becomes calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I will heal them.

(1Peter2:21) To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example that you should follow in his steps.

We may suffer for many reasons. Some suffering is the direct result of our own sin; somethings happen because of our own foolishness; some is the result of living in a fallen world. Peter is writing about a suffering that comes from doing good. Christ never sinned, and yet he suffered so that we could be set free. When we follow Christ's example and live for others, we too may suffer. Our goal should be to face suffering as he did, with

patience, calmness, and confidence that God is in control of the future.

This is what the Lord says: Stand at the crossroad and look: ask for the ancient path, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls. (Jeremiah 6:16) (now read Jeremiah 18:15)

The right path for living is ancient and has been marked out by God. But the people refused to take God's path, going their own way instead. We face the same decisions today; moving in God's one true way, or following a new path of our own choosing. Don't be misled! The only way to find peace and rest for your soul is to walk on God's path.

Who Am I to Say?

I don't know I'm just saying: But AS IT IS WRITTEN! My prayer this morning was, "God, I know I am not perfect so help me be mindful and to treat people the way I want to be treated, according to your Word, your will, and your way. Righteous unto you! I need you Father to show me, lead me and direct my mouth, my mind and my heart."

Then, I opened my bible for my daily read and opened to Micah 7. I looked back up the page and my eyes fell on chapter 6 verse 8 which states:

"He has showed you, O man, what is good.

And what does the Lord requires of you?

To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God." (Micah 7:6-8)

People have tried all kinds of ways to please God (refer to Micah 6:6-7), but God has made his wishes clear: He wants his people to be just, merciful, and to walk humbly with him. In your efforts to please God, examine these areas on a regular basis. Are you fair in your dealings with people? Do you show mercy to those who wrong you? Are you learning humility?

I tell you, I had to sit back and

think. I thought to myself, "God does answer, lead, directs and show us things. It's just that we must be able to hear. And willing to listen and be obedient. I continue to read the verses:

Listen! The Lord is calling to the city-And to fear your name is wisdom-

"Heed the rod and the One who appointed it.

Am I to forget, O wicked house,

Your ill-gotten treasures

Shall I acquit a man with dishonest scales,

with bags of false weights?

Her rich men are violent

Her people are liars

And their tongues speak

deceitfully;

Therefore, I have began to destroy you,

to ruin you because of your sins.

You will eat and not be satisfied;

(Micah 6:9-14)

Micah watched as society rotted around him. Rulers demanded gifts; judges accepted bribes; corruption was universal. But God promised to lead the people out of the darkness of sin and into the light. Then, the people will praise his faithfulness. God alone is perfectly faithful. Even today uprightness (honest, integrity) is difficult to find. Society rationalizes sin and even Christians sometimes compromises Christian principles in order to do what they want. It is easy to convince ourselves that we deserve a few breaks, especially when "everyone else" is doing it. But the standards for honesty come from God, not society. We are honest because God is truth; and we are to be like Him.

I know that some people who have a humble spirit genuinely believe they were wired that way and there is nothing more that need to be done. But here's the thing; we are all born sinners. And we have to be born again with the spirit of God to be in right standing (salvation) with him. We must also seek him and continue to renew our mind in Christ, regardless of how we are wired. We also have to ask for forgiveness of our sins (seen and unseen).

It is written: "for all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God"; (Romans 3:23) "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinner, Christ died for us". (Roman 5:8)" For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Roman 6:3) "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, that shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed." (Roman 10:9-11) "For whosoever call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Roman 10:13)

Sometimes we can get by without instructions, like putting together something man made and throwing away the instructions. But when it comes to putting together a life that reflects the goodness and wisdom of God, we can't afford to ignore the directions He gives us in the Bible. The Israelites wandered in the desert for 40 years because they ignored God. And they saw firsthand what God did for them, just like some of us have. But when God delivered them and as they began to reestablish worship in their homeland, they prepared to do so in accordance with what was written in the Law of Moses. They began to do exactly what God had directed Moses to have told them to do.

At this point in life we do not have to follow the Law of Moses, but Christ gives us directions now. He said, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." And "Love your neighbor as yourself (Matthew 22:37,39). When we believe in Him and come to Him, He shows us the way to live. The One who made us knows far better than we do how life is suppose to work.

Lord, remind us as we start each day that you have given us to live by your example. Help us to read your Word and follow the directions that you have so graciously provided for us!

If we want God to lead us, we must be willing to follow Him. Glory Be To God!!! It is written!!!

Marriage is hard work, but with God you can endure. I have been married now for 21 years and, like many couples, we have had our ups and downs and ins and outs. Before I got saved, my husband and I had been married for five years and we began going through a difficult time learning how to be married. Because we didn't know how and didn't have any examples of what marriage was all about, it was a trial and error at that time.

We had been separated and out of the house from each other when I had been looking for a job and was not able to find one. By then I had become depressed in my marriage, and because my husband and I couldn't figure out how to make it

work, we decided to do a legal separation. As we prepared for court, for the legal separation, we were still being cordial because we loved each other. But, love just wasn't enough, so we went before the judge anyway. She heard what we both had to say but did not grant us the divorce. She told us both to go work it out. Not really knowing what we were supposed to do, we remained separated. A few weeks later I got a call from Roper Temporary Service saying that they had a job for me. However, the issue was that the company that I would be working for, Plaster Line, was the same company where my husband Tony worked. So I told the lady that I didn't want to do

factory work. She told me that it wouldn't be factory work but that I would be doing clerical work and would have my own office. I accepted the job. One day around lunch time, I had my door opened doing paper work when he walked past. He stepped back and did a double take, and looked like, why are you here. So, I told him that it was the only job that I could get but that I was not bothering him. He said to me, "you know what? An old man just told me that someone is praying for us". That's all that he said and then walked out. It made me depressed because I missed him. I started telling a girlfriend about how I was feeling and she

said, "Why don't you call and talk to my pastor?" I figured we had tried everything else, even counseling and nothing seemed to work. So, I said "why not?" That was a Monday, so on that Tuesday I called her and she asked if she could come talk to him and I. On that Wednesday I talked to him about coming to meet the pastor at the house, and he agreed. That Friday she came to the house and she starting talking to us about some of the dreams we were having and the things that we were dealing with. She was very open and she was easy to talk to so we continued meeting with her to discuss our issues. Because of this, we decided to try to make things work.

At that time we were not saved but God started pulling on us, and for me, I didn't understand what God was doing but I remembered praying a prayer before we went to court saying, "Lord if this is your will to fix my marriage then you fix it because I have done everything I know how to do." And God was doing just that, because that Sunday we both went to church and got saved. We have been together ever since.

I can't tell you that it has been a bed of roses but I can tell you that going through this journey have been a blessing from God. That day my husband and I got saved God said to me, "I will teach you how to

war." I said, "We have already been fighting!" But he said, "No, I will teach your hands how to war in the spirit and how to fight in the spirit realm." So, my testimony is that God is a healer. He can mend anything that is broken. He can bring broken homes and marriages back together. He did it for mine.

Love

Our society confuses love with lust and possession. Unlike lust, God's kind of love is directed outward toward others, not inward toward ourselves. It is utterly unselfish. This kind of love goes against our natural inclinations. It is possible to practice this kind of love only if God helps us set aside our own desires and instincts so that we can give love with expecting nothing in return. Thus the more we become like Christ, the more love we will show to others.

15 Characteristics of Love
1 Corinthians (13:4-7)

Love is patient, kind, thinks no evil, it is not puffed up (proud), self seeking, or easily angered (provoked), it does not envy (hate), vaunt itself (boastful), it does not behave rudely, or rejoice in iniquity (evil, keeps no records of wrong doings), it rejoices in truth, bear all things (protects), believes all things (trust), hopes all things, and endures all things.

Now abideth faith, hope, love; but the greatest of these is Love. (1 Corinthians 13:13). And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God and God in him. (1 John 4:16)
With more love we will have a more fulfilled life. It is a commandment God said, "love your neighbor as yourself," (Mark 12:31) this isn't just the people that live next door to you; it is all people. Try to love a little more and see the joy of the Lord work in our lives. You will feel good because you are giving love, others will feel good because they feel loved. In return they will love back. Its reciprocal give it and it comes back.
