Midlands Technical College, Moore School kick off operations and supply chain transfer pathway



(Columbia, S.C.) The University of South Carolina’s Darla Moore School of Business and Midlands Technical College are now offering a transfer pathway that will facilitate MTC students transferring into the Moore School’s operations and supply chain program. The Moore School and MTC celebrated this new pathway with an event on Monday that featured remarks by MTC President Ron Rhames and Provost Barrie Kirk and UofSC Moore School Dean Peter Brews, among others.

“This agreement marks yet another positive step by our two institutions against the background of undeniable opportunities and challenges,” Rhames said. “There is a growing need in the Midlands and across the state for college-graduate supply chain management professionals. Right here in South Carolina, there are multiple global manufacturers and logistics employers needing these skilled professionals. This articulation agreement is both timely and efficient as it creates a clear pathway for students to become part of the world-class supply chain manufacturing and technology industry in our region.”

In the first two years of the pathway, students enrolled at MTC will earn an associate in arts degree with a concentration in business before transferring to the Moore School for their third and fourth years of coursework.

The pathway was created, in part, because the Bureau of Labor Statistics predicts a faster than average job growth outlook in the operations and supply chain field, which globally employs individuals in diverse industries and businesses such as manufacturing, retail, aviation, health care, insurance, hospitality, and technology. A recent DHL Corporation study found that demand for supply chain professionals exceeds supply by an estimated six-to-one ratio.

Operations and supply chain “is in high demand and offers high salaries with careers in South Carolina,” Kirk said. “These students will graduate with so many opportunities in the future.”

“This valuable pathway initiative will help us extend the benefits of cutting-edge operations and supply

chain competencies to an economically diverse student population of our state, and thus expand the program’s direct contributions to the socio-economic development of South Carolina,” said Sanjay Ahire, Moore School professor of operations management and co-director of the UofSC Operations and Supply Chain Center, who led the design and implementation of the operations and supply chain program in 2006.

Overcoming Insecurity

Have you ever desired or considered reaching out to someone or stepping forth toward a goal you wanted to do in life and found yourself focusing on all the reasons why you should not? Perhaps there are underlying insecurities that you may be struggling with. All of us may deal with some element of insecurities, and we deal with them in our own ways, right or wrong. Helps South Carolina Kids

Become Successful in School and Life

Save the Children has worked in South Carolina since 2003, offering critical early childhood education programs for parents and children from prenatal development through third grade. Currently, Save the Children partners with 17 schools in five South Carolina counties, to serve more than 5,000 children and their families. Programs are offered in Barnwell, Clarendon, Lee, Orangeburg and Union Counties.

In a state where 61 percent of 3- and 4-year olds living in poverty do not attend early childhood education programs and 71 percent of fourth graders do not meet grade-level reading standards, Save the Children’s programs are improving children's development, boosting their early literacy and math skills, and preparing them to be successful in school and life.

Save the Children’s programs help children and families living in South Carolina’s most isolated, rural communities, which lack access to early learning programs and struggle with limited services, poverty and unemployment. These programs include:

- **Early Steps to School Success**, a home visiting program for children prenatal through age five that empowers parents to be their child’s first and most important teacher. It helps children build a foundation of language and early literacy and math skills, as well as social and emotional development.
- **Kinder Boost**, a school readiness program that helps children and families make a smooth transition to kindergarten.
- **School-age education programs** during and after school that help kindergarten through third graders improve their reading and math skills, striving for proficiency at the end of third grade.
- **Summer Boost Camp**, which helps children from low-income families maintain the academic gains they made the prior school year, when class is not in session.

Save the Children’s partnerships with rural communities also grow greater economic opportunities for adults, helping train more than 100 local early childhood educators to enter a workforce that’s working wonders for children.

Save the Children opened its new South Carolina office in Orangeburg this past March, located at 903 Chestnut Street. This marks Save the Children’s second field office in the United States, signaling its significant investment in the Palmetto state.

I-26 Widening Project in Lexington, Richland, and Newberry Counties

The S.C. Department of Transportation (SCDOT) announces some preliminary activities that are required to complete the design ahead of construction on the Interstate 26 Widening Design-Build Project in Lexington, Richland and Newberry Counties. The project begins near Exit 101 US 176 and extends to just west of Exit 85 (SC 202). The purpose of this project is to increase roadway capacity, improve safety, and correct deficiencies along the mainline and at several interchanges and overpasses in this section.

Construction of the project will begin in Spring of 2020 and will follow an aggressive schedule with an estimated substantial completion date of November 2023.

During construction, I-26 will be widened to add two additional travel lanes in each direction from approximately Exit 101 (US 176) to Exit 97 (US 176), and one additional travel lane in each direction from just west of

Exit 97 (US 176) to just west of Exit 85 (SC 202). Interchanges will be improved at Exit 97 (US 176), Exit 91 (S-48), and Exit 85 (SC 202). Overpass bridges will be replaced at Koon Road, Shady Grove Road, Mt. Vernon Church Road, Old Hilton Road, Peak Street, Holy Trinity Church Road, and Parr Road. The weigh station at mile marker 94 WB will also be upgraded.

The contractor is currently utilizing routine temporary lane closures on I-26 to safely perform various activities for project design. These lane closures will occur at night when the volume of traffic is reduced. All I-26 travel lanes will remain open during daytime hours to minimize impacts to motorists. Drivers traveling through the construction zone are asked to be aware of equipment and crews working adjacent to traffic at all times.
